To launch a competitive entrance examination and to fix the number of places for admission into the first year of the Faculty of Agriculture and Veterinary Medicine of the University of Buea, for the 2017-2018 academic year

THE MINISTER OF HIGHER EDUCATION,

- Mindful of the constitution;
Mindful of Law No. 005 of 16th April 2001 on the orientation of Higher Education;
Mindful of Decree No. 2011/408 of 09 December 2011 to organize the Government;
Mindful of Decree No. 2011/410 of 09 December 2011 to appoint members of Government;
Mindful of Decree No. 2012/433 of 1st October 2012 to organize the Ministry of Higher Education ;
Mindful of Decree No. 2017/318 of 27 June 2017 to appoint the Vice-Chancellor and Rectors in some State Universities;
Mindful of Decree No. 93/026 of 19th January 1993 to create universities;
Mindful of Decree No. 93/027 of 19 January 1993 to define common dispositions applicable to Universities modified and completed by decree no. 2005/342 of 10 September 2005;
Mindful of Decree No. 93/034 of 19 January 1993 to organize the University of Buea;
Mindful of Decree No. 2012/578 of 4 December 2012 to appoint the Dean of the Faculty of Agriculture and Veterinary Medicine of the University of Buea;
Mindful of Order No. 17/00056/MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC/SE of 25th January 2017 fixing the calendar of the competitive entrance examinations into Cameroon State Universities, for the 2017/2018 academic year.

ORDERS:

Article 1: A competitive entrance examination for admission of two hundred (200) students into the first year of the Faculty of Agriculture and Veterinary Medicine of the University of Buea, for the 2017/2018 academic year, will take place on the following date and at the centres indicated below:

Date: 27 September 2017

Centres: Buea, Bamenda, and Yaounde

The 200 places shall be distributed to programmes as follows:

Article 2: The entrance examination is open to Cameroonians of both sexes who are holders of:

- a) General Certificate of Education Ordinary Level in at least five (05) subjects including English Language, Mathematics, Biology and Chemistry.
- b) General Certificate of Education Advanced Level in at least two (02) science subjects including Biology and Chemistry, or Baccalauréat Series D or C, or any other certificates recognised as equivalent by the Minister of Higher Education.

N.B: A compensatory grade (O) in the GCE Advanced Level Mathematics will be accepted for a pass in Ordinary Level Mathematics.

Article 3: Complete application files must include the following documents:

1. An application form duly filled by the candidate;
2. A certified true copy of the candidate's birth certificate dated not more than 3 months;
3. Certified true copies of the GCE Ordinary Level and Advanced Level certificates or results slips; or
4. Certified true copies of the Probatoire and Baccalauréat Series D or C certificates or transcripts (for Bac holders);
5. An attestation of English Language proficiency (for Bac holders). Interested Bac D or C holders can take the intensive English language course or proficiency test, both offered by the University of Buea from July to September or present a certificate of English Language proficiency issued by a Government Linguistic Centre.
6. A photocopy of the National Identity Card;
7. Four (4) recent coloured passport-size photographs (4cm x 4cm)
8. A receipt of payment of 20,000 (twenty thousand) FCFA, as examination fee, to the Faculty of Agriculture and Veterinary Medicine, University of Buea bank account in:

Article 4: The application fee is non-refundable.

Article 5: Application forms and supporting documents shall be available at the Universities of Buea, Ngaoundere, and Maroua; Presbook branches in Yaounde, Bamenda, and Douala; and Regional Delegations of Secondary Education in Yaounde, Ebolowa, Douala, Bafoussam, and Bamenda

Article 6: Complete application files shall be submitted at the collection points listed in Article 5 above not later than **Friday, 22 September 2017**.

Article 7: Only candidates who submit complete application files shall be allowed to write the examination.

Article 8:a. The examination shall be written in the following subjects:

Subject	Duration of the examination
Biology	3 hours
Chemistry	3 hours

b. The examination shall be set on the GCE Advanced Level syllabus or the Bac programme.


c. Each paper shall be marked out of 50 and the candidate's final mark shall be the average of the marks scored in the two papers.

Article 9: Candidates shall report at the examination centres 30 minutes before the start of the examination, bringing along their national identity cards or school identity cards for identification.

Article 10: The results of the examination shall be prepared by a panel appointed by the Minister of Higher Education, on the proposal of the Vice-Chancellor of the University of Buea.

Article 11: The list of successful candidates shall be published by the Minister of Higher Education.

Article 12: The Vice-Chancellor of the University of Buea, the Director of University Accreditations and Quality, and the Dean of the Faculty of Agriculture and Veterinary Medicine of the University of Buea shall be responsible, each in his/her own sphere, for the implementation of this order which shall be registered and published wherever need be.
