The Vice-Chancellor of the University of Buea informs the public and stakeholders of the University that the deadline to receive applications for admission into the undergraduate programmes for the Faculties of Arts, Education, Science and Social and Management Sciences is Monday, 16 October 2017 while the deadline for applications for admission into all postgraduate programmes is Thursday, 9 November 2017. Applicants should apply online on the University's website (www.ubuea.cm).

Prospective applicants (for undergraduate degree programmes) who are holders of the GCE Advanced Level or Baccalaureat are encouraged to apply.

It should be noted that the University of Buea has successfully completed the 2016/2017 academic year. The second semester examination results have been published and students are informed that their results are now available online for verification.


The Summer School for 1st semester courses that had a coverage of below 70% is currently going on and Resit and Summer School Examinations will run from 12-26 October 2017. Students concerned should consult their departments for registration formalities which ends on Wednesday, 11 October 2017.

The University is set to serve its students and the public better in the 2017/2018 academic year. The payment of registration fees, medical fees and registration into courses for all fresh and returning students will run from October 15 to November 31, 2017. All returning students are therefore advised to begin the registration procedure on the 15th of October 2017. Lectures will officially begin on 27 November 2017.

The low performance at the GCE examination should not discourage prospective applicants from applying.
