

## Press Release Extra-Ordinary Meeting of Council of the University of Buea

An Extra-Ordinary meeting of the Council of the University of Buea held on Thursday, 28 May 2020 in the Boardroom of the Central Administrative Building. The meeting was chaired by Professor Ako Edward Oben, Pro-Chancellor and Chairman of Council.

The main items of the agenda were the presentation, examination and approval of Transfer of Credits on the 2020 budget of the University of Buea, and the endorsement of promotion and advancement of teaching staff.

After further deliberations, the Council;

- Approved the University's proposal for the transfer of credits within some budget lines of the running budget estimates of the University of Buea for the 2020 financial year amounting to 330.460.000FCFA (three hundred and thirty million, four hundred and sixty thousand francs) and commended the University for this initiative that will enable it to meet up with its emerging challenges;
- Endorsed the advancement and promotion of some members of the academic staff of the University of Buea as presented;
- Approved the proposal of the University to designate two representatives from other State Universities to be members of the Consultative Committee for the Recruitment of Assistant Lecturers of the University of Buea;
- Congratulated the Vice-Chancellor and his collaborators on the excellent performance of the University of Buea especially in the implementation of the measures put in place by WHO and the Cameroon government to fight against COVID19 such as the provision of hand-washing points and hand sanitizers in all buildings, the practice of social distancing, and the wearing of face masks;
- Commended the University for instituting alternative methods of teaching and learning, driven by information and communication technologies.

Finally, Council thanked the government for its sustained financial and material support to enable the University achieve its vision and mission.
